Background



Climatic variability and extremes, temporarily or permanently reduce the response and capacity of human populations. Massive damage to the environment, economic loss, disruption, injury, and/or loss of life are a few of its outfall. Besides the loss to lives and physical resources, the frequent occurrences of climate extreme events like drought, flood, heat-wave, cyclones etc have adversely affected agricultural productivity and food supplies. Economic valuation of damages due to climate extreme events is challenged by the diversity and complexity of social systems and agro-ecosystems. However, this is inevitable to support post-disaster recovery planning and management. The resilience of farmers towards climate extremes is regarded as an effective strategy for enhancing disaster preparedness, response and recovery. It is also very crucial for maintaining livelihood

security. Quantifying and valuing the impact of climate extremes, accommodating the long term and short term losses and gains, warrants multidisciplinary approach and application of emerging and novel technologies.

In this backdrop, a seminar on “Climate extremes, economic loss and farmer resilience” is organized jointly by ISAE and Kerala Agricultural University on 11th and 12th November 2021. It aims to understand and navigate successfully through various aspects of climate change impact studies and to address some of the challenges faced in the research. The conference is open to academicians, researchers and students working in the field of Agriculture, Climate change, Environmental Economics and Natural Resource management to share and enrich their knowledge.

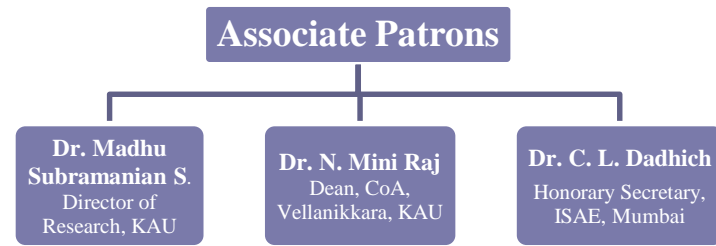
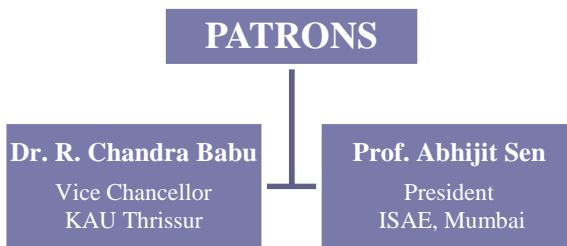
