# Ph.D. Theses in Agricultural Economics Completed in Universities in India: 2002-2004

In pursuance of the decision to publish information on completed Ph.D. Theses in Agricultural Economics from Universities/academic institutions in India on a regular basis, in the last issue of the Journal every year, a questionnaire was canvassed in March 2004 to 75 Universities/Institutions, seeking the required information for the academic years 2002-2004.
